

How to Determine Application Score for the NKU Nursing Application

Your application score is made up of two parts: your GPA & your grades in pre-requisite and other supporting courses.

The NKU Nursing program will accept a cumulative GPA (sum of all college work) of a 3.0 or higher OR a GPA made up of the last 30 credit hours of college level work that is a 3.0 or higher.

Please note: C's are accepted, but do not merit any points; any grade C- and below will need to be repeated (C- and below in any science course is considered a Nursing science failure; you can only have 1 semester of science failures within 2 years of applying to the program).

The following courses with qualifying grades are worth points toward your application score:
